Directions from Bristol end of Long Ashton. It's 1/2 mile on the left after The Angel Inn. Look out for a zebra crossing and Theynes Croft, a turning on the left. The building is the first, lovely reddish building 50 yards on the left. You can temporarily park outside on the main road to unload but the car park entrance is back down Theynes Croft on the right below/in front of the building; you have to walk back onto the main road to access the hall entrance – allow 5 mins to do this.

Directions from the Flax Bourton end of Long Ashton. Long Ashton is long. Go past the turning for the community centre (our rehearsal place) for just over ½ mile. Church House is on the right opposite a turning called Northleaze. You can temporarily park outside on the main road to unload, but park in the official car park which is beyond / below Church House. Drive on 50 yards or so and turn right down Theynes Croft. The car park entrance is on the right below/in front of the building; you have to walk back onto the main road to access the hall entrance – allow 5 mins to do this.
